About the School of International Education









The School of International Education (SIE) at Dalian Neusoft University of Information is responsible for planning and implementing university's international engagement. SIE offers degree and non-degree education for overseas students and study-abroad opportunities for Chinese students at DNUI. Currently, international students mainly come from Russia, Japan, South Korea, Thailand and the USA. SIE offers minor undergraduate programs in Chinese Language for any international students who enrolled in a DNUI bachelor's program.

We also provide foundation Chinese language courses for students planning to study degree courses taught in Chinese, long-term/short-term Language & Culture programs, staff training, and etc. In 2012, DNUI became the first HSK online test center in Dalian authorized by Hanban (National Chinese Language Office).

- 3 Recommendation letter: using the template of DNUI.
- 4 Final graduation certificate or schooling certificate: Original official transcript is needed.
- **3** Academic transcript of the highest degree with ranking or percentage: the original official transcript.
- 6 Certification of No Criminal Record issued by the police
- 7 Physical Examination Record within 3 months
- 8 Electronic file and 3 printed passport photos of applicant taken within 3 months
- 9 A copy of the front page and visa page of your passport
- 10 Authorization to the Guardian for applicants under 18 years old.
